


This is in continuation to Council's circular dt. 30.7.2015. In this connection, it is informed that subject cited issue was again placed in 265th Executive Committee meeting of the PCI held in August, 2015 and relevant decision is as under-

- "It was noted that the 97th CC (June, 2015) has approved that a student who has excelled from Open School education system of the Central Govt./State Govt. institutions be made eligible for admission to pharmacy courses as per the concerned Education Regulations.
- It was further decided to recommend to the Central Council that the students of such Open Schools who have already passed or are undergoing pharmacy courses shall be treated as eligible for registration as a pharmacists under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 subject to fulfilment of the other prescribed conditions of registration under the Pharmacy Act, 1948.

The above recommendations are subject to ratification by the Central Council.
