

- Read the instructions carefully before filling the Online Application Form.
- All the columns should be properly filled. No column should be left incomplete/blank.
- The supporting documents should be uploaded along with the main Application Form.
- Payment of Admission and Examination fee has to be done through ONLINE mode only. No other mode of payment will be accepted.
- It is mandatory to submit the ORIGINAL MARKSHEET while applying for the Transfer of Credit.
- Learners are required to attend Personal Contact Programme (PCP) in each subject which is conducted by Study Centers.
- Assignments should be submitted timely to the respective Study Centers.
- Correct E-mail ID and mobile number should be provided to facilitate SMS alerts.



GENESIS

BOSSE (Board of Open Schooling & Skill Education), Sikkim is an Open School Board to cater to the varied academic needs of divergent groups of students up to pre degree level. It offers Secondary and Senior Secondary Courses for all students, imparting Skill & Vocational education, along with academic education. It was established under an Act of the Sikkim Government (Act No. 14/LD of 2020, passed on 21-09-2020 by the Sikkim Legislative Assembly and notified through Gazette Notification on 08-10-2020.

With the aim of strengthening school education across the country, BOSSE has been authorized by the Government of Sikkim to:

- impart education at the Secondary, Senior Secondary level with Skill & Vocational education.
- conduct examinations and issue certificates at Secondary, Senior Secondary level and Skill & Vocational education.

- Flexible Education, with no restriction on place and pace of study, choice of subjects, etc.

- BOSSE Pass-outs can apply for admission to any reputed higher educational institutions across the country and world.

The admission to Secondary and Senior Secondary Programmes are open round the year in two blocks as below:

BLOCK-1 From 1ST MAR – 31ST AUG (without late fees) Examinations in April-May of next year BLOCK-2 From 1ST SEP – 28/29th FEB (without late fees) Examinations in October-November of same year

- The candidates can take admission online directly or go to the Study Centres for admission.
- Candidates can avail 9 chances in 5 years to pass all the 5 subjects and qualify for the certificate.
- The benefit of Transfer of Credits can be availed by candidates who have failed or kept under compartment in other recognized Boards.



Facility of Credit Transfer

The facility of TOC will be permissible under the following conditions:

- ✓ If a learner has appeared in the Secondary/Senior Secondary examination of any recognized State/National/International Board of School Education/Open School, but has failed to qualify for the certificate, though passing in at least one subject, he/shemay avail BOSSE's TOC facility for up to four subjects. In this case, the learner is required to get his/her Marks Sheet/TOC data verified from the concerned Board and submit the verified Marks Sheet/TOC data along with the Admission Application Form.
- ✓ TOC is admissible for up to 4 subjects. The remaining subject/s has/have to be chosen
 from among the subjects available in BOSSE Scheme of Studies and BOSSE Scheme of
 Examinations. However, a learner will qualify for the certificate only if he/she passes 5
 subjects, including minimum one Language Subject, as per the Passing Criteria of
 BOSSE.
- ✓ The learner will have to pay the requisite fee for Transfer of Credit at the time of admission as follows:
 - Rs. 1000/- as Registration Fee
 - Rs. 1000/- per subject as credit transfer fee
 - Examination Fee will be separate as per the rules of BOSSE.
 - Fee of Subjects from BOSSE shall be as specified above.
- ✓ While applying for Transfer of Credit (TOC), the learner is required to submit the original Fail/Compartment Marks Sheet, along with a copy of the Acknowledgement Receipt/Copy of the Online Admission Form, within 10 days after online admission. In case of delay in submission i.e. submission after 10 days, a late fee of Rs. 500/- per subject of TOC will be charged.



Curriculum, Syllabus and Study Materials

The Curricula/Syllabi as well as Study Materials (based on NEP 2020/NCF 2023), in all the subjects of Secondary and SeniorSecondary, are available on the website of BOSSE. The learners can either download the same or study online.

The learners can also purchase printed study materials on payment of nominal charges.

BOSSE has made special arrangements for providing learning support to its learners through its Study Centres (also called Accredited Institutes), which have been setup in reputed schools in all the states, having all required infrastructure. BOSSE also provides online support to its learners.

Study Centres of BOSSE


Study Centres (or Accredited Institutions) play an important role in the ODL (Open & Distance Learning) System.

BOSSE has set up Accredited Institutions (AI) in all parts of the country and abroad for face to face contact.

These Study Centres are located in recognised reputed schools affiliated to different National/International/State School Education Boards.

In Addition to this, BOSSE has also set up Information Centres as well as Resource Centres in Colleges/Universities to provide support to the learners.

A List of present Als/Study Centres is given in the BOSSE website.





CHANGE OF SUBJECT

The details of subjects in Secondary/Senior Secondary Programmes are available on the website of BOSSE.

Candidates can change their subject/s after taking admission and appearing in at least one examination.

The fee for change of subject/s is Rs. 500/- per subject for Secondary as well as Senior Secondary Programme.

Note: Although there is no restriction on choosing the subjects by the learner yet he/she should keep in mind the norms of the Universities or Boards if he/she intends to take admission for higher studies. BOSSE will not be responsible if any candidate has passed with a subject combination which is not as per the norms of any University Institutions of higher education.

As per the philosophy of Open Schooling, there are no streams like Science, Commerce or Arts. So, any combination is allowed. However, it may be difficult for the date sheet of the examination to take care of all combinations. A candidate may have to take up the examination of some subject/s in the next public examination.



Part Admission

BOSSE also provides the facility of Part admission to the candidates studying in some regular course or already passed out candidates of secondary/Senior secondary.

A learner will have to pay a sum of Rs. 1000/- as Registration Fee and Rs. 1000/ per subject under the Scheme of Part Admission. Examination Fee will be separate as per the rules of BOSSE.

A learner can take admission under this scheme in maximum of 4 subjects and will be issued only MarksSheet.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

The admission of a learner will be cancelled if:

- admission form is incomplete;
- fee is not paid in full;
- supporting documents are not complete;
- false documents have been submitted;
- required educational qualifications are not met;
- minimum age criterion is not satisfied;
- incorrect information is given;
- the Secondary examination is not passed from a recognize board.

Note: Admission once cancelled will not be re-considered.



Assessment & Evaluation

A. Internal Assessment/Student Assignments

Internal Assessment /Student Assignments are important tools for continuous assessment or Formative Evaluation of learners during their studies. The learners admitted in BOSSE Programmes will be assessed through these tools.

The internal assessment shall carry 20% weight age in each subject.

There will be one Student Assignment in each subject, which will be available on the BOSSE website.

The BOSSE may ask for field work as a part of project under Internal Assessment.

As such, non-submission of Assignment by the learner will neither debar him/her from appearing in the examination or declaration of result. But, he/she will lose marks of Assignment and therefore awarded marks out of 80 in the term-end examination, with Zero Marks in the Assignment.

B. Public Examinations

BOSSE will conduct examinations twice a year in the months of April-May and October-Nov. Examinations may be online, too. Physical examinations will normally be held at Als of BOSSE.

For appearing in examinations, a candidate has to register after filling up an examination form and paying the prescribed examination fee.

A candidate will get nine chances to clear the examination after taking admission and complete all academic requirements.

C. On Demand Examination

BOSSE will offer on Demand Examination facility shortly to learners. Under this facility, the learners can appear for the examination of any subject, as and when they are ready to take the examination.



Pass/Certification Criteria

Note:

For the purpose of certification at Senior Secondary level, a gap of two years from the year of passing the Secondary Examination is mandatory.

Result Declaration and Award of Certificate

The Result for Secondary and Senior Secondary Programmes shall be declared within 45 to 60 working days after the last examination held.

Details of Marks Cum Certificate will be issued to all successful students, who have qualified as per the Pass/Certification Criteria.

Other candidates, who have appeared in the examination, but have not qualified as per the Pass/Certification Criteria will be issued only a Marks Sheet, which will show the marks obtained in all subjects in which they have appeared.



FAQs (FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIOS)

- 1) What does BOSSE stand for, and what sets it apart from other School Education Boards?
 BOSSE stands for "Board of Open Schooling and Skill Education." What distinguishes BOSSE is its emphasis on open educational learning, vocational subjects, and an advanced learning program that caters to diverse educational needs.
- 2) What subjects are covered in the open educational learning program for 10th and 12th grades?
 - Complete details can be accessed under the title "Programmes" on bosse.ac.in.
- 3) Can students from different regions or countries participate in BOSSE's program? Yes, BOSSE's program is open to students from all over the countryand beyond.
- 4) How does BOSSE provide Student Support Services? BOSSE has set up Study Centres in recognized schools affiliated to National or State Boards of School Education. These Study Centres are also called Accredited Institutions (Als). The major role of Study Centres is to synchronize between learners and BOSSE. They are meant to assist the learners in every way.
- 5) Can students pursue vocational subjects alongside their academic subjects?
 Yes, students have the opportunity to study vocational subjects concurrently with their academic subject, enabling them to gain practical skills and knowledge.
- 6) What does the advanced learning program entail, and who is eligible for it?

 The advanced learning program is designed for high-achieving students seeking a more challenging learning opportunity. Eligibility criteria typically include academic performance and a passion for deeper learning.
- 7) Are the Programmes provided by BOSSE recognized by universities for higher education? All our Recognition and Approvals along with RTI replies from different universities are displayed on the website.
- 8) How flexible is the curriculum for students who might need personalized learning paths?

 BOSSE offers a flexible curriculum to accommodate individual learning needs, allowing students to customize their educational paths to suit their pace and learning styles. Student can choose any combination of subjects, depending on their need, interest and ability.
- 9) Are there any specific eligibility criteria or prerequisites for enrolling in BOSSE Programmes?
 - Eligibility criteria vary based on the program. Generally, students need to meet age criteria and comply with specific educational prerequisites.
- 10) How does BOSSE integrate technology into its educational Programmes?
 BOSSE integrates technology through online resources, e-learning platforms, and interactive tools to enhance learning experiences.
- 11) What are the assessment methods used by BOSSE to evaluate student progress/achievement?
 - BOSSE uses various assessment methods to evaluate student progress, including assignments for Continuous Internal Assessment, Practicals, and Public Examinations. Question Papers include various forms of test items Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs), as well as descriptive questions.
